**CALL FOR PAPERS**

The University of Belgrade, in collaboration with University College London and the Institute of Classical Studies, is hosting an international conference on Greek and Roman poetics, which will take place in Belgrade from 4 to 8 October 2011. Papers are invited both from established scholars and from younger researchers; we hope to include papers both on larger themes such as origins, evolution, competing/contesting/contrasting models and also more specific papers on topics such as style and genre(s), reception (both within antiquity and from antiquity to the modern era), and comparisons/contrasts between Greek/Roman poetics and the poetics of other cultures and periods.

We anticipate that papers, which should be new contributions pitched at research level, will not be longer than 30 minutes in length. Proposals (including title and abstract of no more than 200 words) should be sent by 22 November 2010 to Ana Petković ( [poetics.conference@live.co.uk](mailto:poetics.conference@live.co.uk) ) and copied to Chris Carey ( [c.carey@ucl.ac.uk](mailto:c.carey@ucl.ac.uk) ).

As well as providing a forum for intellectual exchange, we shall also find time to introduce participants to the rich classical archaeological sites of Serbia.
